### Start of works on Docker St car park and multi-storey car park, 19 August

Works are progressing well on the \$30 million multi-storey car park project at Wagga Wagga Base Hospital to deliver car parking spaces for patients, visitors and staff. Phase 1 is nearing completion with over 70 new street level car spaces on Yathong Street available from end of August.

The project is being delivered in three phases to minimise the loss of parking during construction and to allow new car parking spaces to become available as works progress. The entire project is due to be completed in late-2022.

From **19 August 2021**, the contractor will be establishing the construction sites for the new car park on Docker Street (Phase 2) and the new multi-storey car park facing Edward Street (Phase 3). See map overleaf. Before main works can start, the contractor will be preparing the work zones. Activities include:

- \* Fencing and hoarding installed around work zones
- \* Delivery of site sheds via trucks
- \* Construction traffic access and egress will be via Docker Street, Brookong Avenue, Murray Avenue, Rawson Lane, Edward Street, Yabtree Street and Lewis Drive.
- \* Installation of erosion and sediment control devices
- \* Installation of wayfinding for temporary access, traffic and pedestrian diversions.

Working hours are Monday to Friday, 7:00am - 6:00pm, Saturdays 8:00am - 1pm. No work will occur on Sundays or Public Holidays, unless otherwise advised. All work will be within NSW Government's Public Health Orders and relevant COVID restrictions.

We are working with our contractors to implement strategies that minimise disruption to nearby residents and businesses. Temporary pedestrian diversions and traffic management continue to be in place while these works are underway.
