SUBJECT: Wagga Wagga Multi Storey Car Park project – Planning Approval

A multi storey car park at Wagga Wagga Base Hospital has moved a step closer with approval of the Development Application by the Joint Regional Planning Panel on Thursday 25 February 2021.

The Development Application for the project was lodged by Health Infrastructure late last year.

The contract for the multi storey car park project construction works is expected to be awarded in the coming months.

The \$30 million Wagga Wagga Car Park project includes:

- a 6-level car park on the health campus for 360 vehicles for patients, staff and visitors. The car park will be located in northeast corner of the campus in the area where temporary ambulatory care clinics are currently located.
- on-grade car parking will be available at 2 different sites on the health campus.

After the completion of the \$431 million Wagga Wagga Hospital Redevelopment and the \$30 million car park project, there will be car parking spaces for more than 900 vehicles to park across the campus – this is more than double current capacity.

Construction of the car park project will commence in mid-2021 and be completed in 2022.

This staged process is required to deliver uninterrupted services on the health campus, as some existing services are currently located within the new multi storey car park footprint. These will be relocated into the new Health Services Hub building at Wagga Wagga Base Hospital over the coming months and enable construction to commence.
