WORKS SET TO START ON WAGGA WAGGA BASE HOSPITAL CAR PARKING

Construction of the \$30 million car park at Wagga Wagga Base Hospital will soon begin as a result of the contract being awarded to ADCO Constructions.

The Australian-owned company has been contracted to construct the multi-storey car park, as well as additional street-level car parking at two other sites on the health campus.

The parking project will provide parking spaces for more than 900 vehicles across the campus, which is more than double the current parking capacity.

In welcoming the contract award, Chief Executive for Murrumbidgee Local Health District (MLHD), Jill Ludford said, "This project will make it easier for patients, visitors and staff to park on the health campus and access health care and work."

Construction work is scheduled to commence in June and be completed in late-2022.

The awarding of the contract follows approval of the project's Development Application by the Joint Regional Planning Panel in February 2021.

The \$30 million project includes planning, design and delivery of a six-level free car park and two new street-level car park sites. The project follows the \$431 million Wagga Wagga Health Service Redevelopment in 2021.
