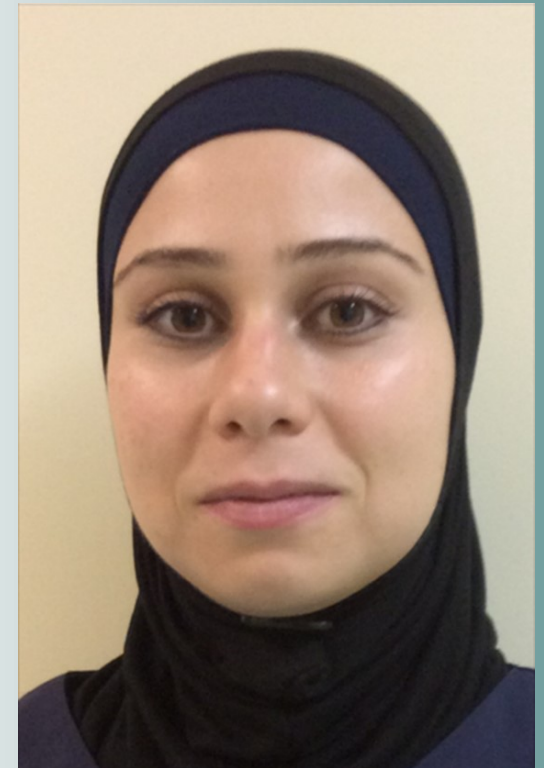

**Having a Cervical Screening test can save your life!**

### **What is a Cervical Screening Test?**

A vaginal examination that tests for the common Human Papillomavirus (HPV) that can cause cervical abnormalities.

### **Do I need a Cervical Screening Test if I am Well?**

Yes, the Cervical Screening Test is for well women aged between 25 and 74 years.

### **Do I need the test if I have had the cervical cancer vaccine (HPV vaccine)?**

Yes, you still need the test as the vaccine does not protect against all the HPV viruses that may cause cervical abnormalities.

### **Will the Cervical Screening Test hurt?**

No, the test is very safe and simple, you may just feel a little uncomfortable.

### **How will I get my results?**

The Women's Health Nurse will let you know your results within 4 weeks.

### **How much will a Cervical Screening Test Cost?**

There is no cost for the Cervical Screening Test, just remember to bring your Medicare card with you on the day of your appointment.



### **Did you know.....**

The new Cervical Screening Test is every 5 years. It replaces the 2 yearly Pap test.
