



ARTIST'S IMPRESSION

The NSW Government is investing \$30 million in the construction of a new multi-storey car park and two street-level car parks on the Wagga Wagga Base Hospital campus for patients, visitors and staff.

The Wagga Wagga Base Hospital Multi-storey Car Park project will deliver more than 900 parking spaces on the campus.

Project Update

Following the site establishment works in August to set up the site and fence the work zones, we are ready to start the demolition of Lewis House and the dental clinic on Docker Street and commence the site preparation works on Edward/Yabtree Street for the multi-storey car park.

What to expect

Works for end of September and October will include:

Edward and Yabtree Street – Multi-storey car park

- Site preparation works
- Remove Demountable Buildings with crane

Docker Street

- Site preparation works
- Removal of demountable buildings
- Commencement of internal demolition activities to Lewis House and the Dental Clinic

Yathong Street car park – now open

There are now 81 new street level car spaces available to staff on Yathong Street with Phase One completed. The project is being delivered in three phases to minimise the loss of parking during construction and to allow new car parking spaces to become available as works progress.

Safety measures

Prior site investigations have indicated that bonded asbestos exists in the excavated ground areas, and removal of that material is required. All work will be conducted in accordance with the Department's Asbestos Management Plan, the Contractor's Demolition Management Plan and Safe Work NSW requirements. Safety measures have been put in place to ensure there is no risk to patients, visitors, staff, neighbours or the local community. The area has been secured and appropriate controls are installed and all asbestos-containing material will be removed by a licensed asbestos removal contractor. The health, safety and well-being of patients, visitors, staff, neighbours and the local community is our highest priority.



Working hours

Working hours are Monday to Friday, 7:00am - 6:00pm, Saturdays 8:00am - 1:00pm. No work will occur on Sundays or Public Holidays, unless otherwise advised. All work will be within NSW Government's Public Health Orders and relevant COVID restrictions.

Traffic management

We are working with our contractors to implement strategies that minimise disruption to nearby residents and businesses. Temporary pedestrian diversions and traffic management continue to be in place while these works are underway.
