\$30 MILLION WAGGA WAGGA MULTI-STOREY CAR PARK A STEP CLOSER

Health Infrastructure has reached a key milestone for the multi-storey car park project at Wagga Wagga Base Hospital with the lodgement of the Development Application to Wagga Wagga City Council.

The NSW Government is investing \$30 million in the planning, design and construction of additional car parking spaces on the Wagga Wagga health campus.

The project includes:

- Six-level car park for staff, patients and visitors to Wagga Wagga Base Hospital
- Additional at grade car parking on two separate sites on the health campus

Rebecca Wark Chief Executive Health Infrastructure said, “At the completion of the \$431 million Wagga Wagga Health Service Redevelopment and the \$30 million Multi Storey Car Park project, there will be over 900 car parking spaces on the health campus.”

This is more than double the existing parking capacity on the campus.

Construction of the multi storey car park will commence after the final stage of the Redevelopment is operational in 2021. This staged process is required to deliver uninterrupted hospital services, as some existing services are temporarily located within the new car park footprint.

The contract for the multi storey car park project construction works is expected to be awarded in early 2021.
