

COLOURING COMPETITION | TERMS AND CONDITIONS

By submitting an entry into the Colouring Competition, you agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions. Any instructions or information on how to enter the Competition also form part of these Terms and Conditions.

1. The purpose of this competition is to colour in a construction site image representing the Wagga Wagga Base Hospital Multi-Storey Car Park project site.
2. Entries are open exclusively to primary school aged children residing in Wagga Wagga.
3. The Competition will open on Monday 22 August 2022 and close on Friday 9 September 2022. Entries received after the closing date will not be eligible for entry into the Competition.

4. To enter the Competition, entrants must:
 - a. Complete the Entry Form by colouring in the picture (an Entry Form is available at [Wagga Wagga Base Hospital Multi-Storey Car Park Project - MLHD \(nsw.gov.au\)](https://www.nsw.gov.au/wagga-wagga-base-hospital-multi-storey-car-park-project-mlhd));
 - b. Provide necessary contact details including name, address, age, parental/guardian or teacher permission, and parent/guardian or teacher number and email address; and
 - c. Submit the completed entry by post, email or delivery as detailed below.

5. To be eligible to enter the Competition, entrants must obtain permission from their parent/guardian or teacher on the Entry Form. By providing parental/teacher consent on the Entry Form, the entrant's parent or teacher consents to be bound by these terms and conditions of entry in their own right and on behalf of the entrant and warrants that:

- a. the entrant, so far as possible, understands the statements and obligations in these terms and conditions; and
 - b. the entry is the entrant's own original work, and has not been copied from any other entry or have any overt assistance from other students, teachers, family or friends.
6. Each entrant may only enter the Competition once and can only enter in their own name.
 7. The student with the winning entry will receive a guided tour of the Multi-Storey Car Park Construction site and a \$200 gift voucher provided by ADCO.
 8. The winning student's primary school will receive a gift voucher valued at \$500, provided by ADCO.
 9. \$100.00 gift vouchers will be awarded to the second and third place getters, provided by ADCO.
 10. If the winning entry is submitted by an individual that is not affiliated with a primary school, ADCO will select a participating school to receive the \$500 gift voucher.
 11. Prizes are not transferable or exchangeable and cannot be taken as cash.
 12. Collection of the prize will be at Wagga Wagga Base Hospital. Any transport costs or ancillary costs to attend are the winner's responsibility.
 13. Judging will be completed by selected Wagga Wagga Base Hospital staff and representatives of the Multi-storey Car Park project team, which includes ADCO. Entries will be judged on artistic merit given the child's age. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
 14. Entries which are incomplete, incorrect, offensive, non-serious or incomprehensible are not eligible to win, and may be rejected or removed, at the absolute discretion of the judges. The judges also reserve the right to disqualify any person it finds to be acting dishonestly or in violation of these Terms and Conditions.
 15. Each entry is the property of Health Infrastructure, and it has no obligation to return an entry to an entrant.
 16. The entrant grants Health Infrastructure a royalty-free, exclusive, irrevocable and perpetual licence to exercise all copyright and other intellectual property rights subsisting in the entry for any purpose and in any

manner, including but not limited to reproduction, communication, adaptation and publication of the entry. This licence includes the right to sublicense the entry without notice to the entrant (including any winner), their parent or their legal guardian.

Health Infrastructure or the Wagga Wagga Base Hospital is not liable for any costs occurred by the entrants due to their participation in this Competition, or any loss or damage arising from use or ownership of the prizes. No responsibility will be taken for loss or damage or entries not received.
20. In the event of force majeure or if circumstances so dictate, Health Infrastructure reserves the right to suspend, postpone, modify or cancel the Competition at any time and without prior notice, in which event entrants will not be entitled to claim compensation in any form.

Your information will not be shared with any other organisation or used for any sales purposes.
